### **Inaugural Session and Key Note Address:-**

The Inaugural Session began with the lightening of the lamp and prayer involving goddess saraswati. Vice Principal Dr.Hasso Dadlani presented the welcome speech. Organizing Secretary Dr.Mukesh Kumar Sharma introduced the theme for the workshop. The session was presided over by Dr.S.K.Deo, Principal of the College. The keynote address was delivered by the Chief Guest Professor Bhagwati Prasad Sharma, Vice-Chancellor, Pacific University, Udaipur a well renowned researcher in the field of IPR. He started his talk by emphasizing upon the importance of the Intellectual Property and said that paper currency or any other wealth is insignificant as compared to the Intellectual Property. His deliberation was intended to focus on the immensity of potential that India as an Intellectual super power has. He then very comprehensively explained about patent-system, history of Indian patent system, patentable subject matter, copyright policy as governed by WTO and Indian Patent Act. He also explained the different types of Intellectual Property including Copyright, Patent, Trademark, Industrial Designs, Undisclosed information and Geographical Indicators. He further said that it is need of the time to generate more Intellectual Property because then only our country can progress and prosper.

### **Technical Session I:-**

After the inaugural session the first Technical Session was delivered by Dr.Manish Kumar Gupta, Professor, MBM Engineering College, Jodhpur on “Patentable Subject from Indian Perspectives”. He explained the term patent and discussed the importance and significance of IPR specially in the field of research and publication. He further talked about the criteria for patentability stating that any product or process which is novel, not obvious to a person skilled in the art and capable of industrial application can be patentable. He also discussed in detail section 3 of the Patent act regarding non-patentable subject matter.

### **Technical Session II:-**

In the 2<sup>nd</sup> Technical session Dr.Govind Sharma, Ex-Head, IPR Division, National Research Development Corporation, New Delhi gave a very lucid and interactive talk on Awareness in Intellectual Property Right and delivered an interesting lecture on “An Overview of IPR for the Academicians”. He provided basic information about IPR, its importance and scope. He touched on various issues such as code of conduct for researchers, ethical issues, plagiarism, scanning of publications for potential IP prior to publication etc. His address proved to be of immensely beneficial for the participants.

## **Technical Session III:-**

In the next technical session Dr.Rohit Jain, IPR Attorney was the resource person. The topic of his lecture was “Overview of the trademark, copyright and geographical indicators”. Since he is an IPR attorney he focused on the legal aspect of the subject. In his lecture the three important components of IPR that is copyright, trademark and geographical indicators were significantly explained. To provide more insight into the matter Dr. Jain also explained about trademark registration, copyright protection, copyright registration, copyright notice etc.

## **Technical Session IV and Valedictory Session:-**

In the last technical session the concept of Patent, its identification and creation was covered by Dr.Jitendra Sharma, Examiner of Patents and Design, DIPP, Govt. of India, New Delhi, who himself is a well known name in the filed of patents and design. In his address he kept the audience interested in the concept till the end.

The valedictory session was chaired by Dr.P.C.Sethi Vice Principal of the college. Vote of thanks presented by Co-coordinator Dr.Sushil K.Bissu.

The workshop was attended by faculty members, researchers, PhD students and masters students of host institute and other institutes around ajmer and outside of Ajmer districts.
