Program Outcome of Geography:-

- ❖ The curriculum for various programmes in Geography is comprehensive and coherent, infusing a holistic understanding of the subject. Students not only gain knowledge of two broad branches of Geography i.e. Physical Geography and Human Geography, but also of other specialized branches and fields of the subject. Program specific outcomes:

- Physical Geography engraves an understanding about the Earth's natural features, elements, processes, along with the various phenomena of Earth's lithosphere, atmosphere, hydrosphere and biosphere.
- Human Geography focuses and equips the students with an analytical perspective of anthropogenic environments along with the socio-cultural-political and economic aspects of human development.
- ❖ Geography also imparts factual conceptual and procedural knowledge of the plethora of interactions of the living world with their environment and the way different places, locations and their physical attributes can have an impact on organisms and human development.
- A student pursuing the Master's program in Geography seeks to understand various geographical features and elements, their significance and their spatial and temporal evolution and development. Thus, Geography enables the study of changes in spatial attributes in a temporal perspective.
